Definitions, Sources and Methods

Gross domestic product

Gross domestic product is an aggregate measure of production equal to the sum of the gross values added of all resident institutional units engaged in production (plus any taxes, and minus any subsidies, on products not included in the value of their outputs). The sum of the final uses of goods and services (all uses except intermediate consumption) measured in purchasers' prices, less the value of imports of goods and services, or the sum of primary incomes distributed by resident producer units.

Germany

The statistics for Germany in this publication refer to Germany after unification. Official data for Germany after unification are available only from 1991 onwards. In order to calculate the various zones totals, the secretariat has estimated data for the whole of Germany back to 1970 by linking in 1991 the data for Germany to historical data for West Germany according to SNA 1993 published in September 2006 by the Statistisches Bundesamt.
